SUBJECT: Type II Amendment to the Hudson Area Sewer Service Plan

Dear Ms. Denzer:

We have completed our review of the subject Type II amendment request that was submitted to the Department on July 19, 2007. The Department hereby conditionally approves the amendment that adds 42 acres to the Hudson Area Sewer Service Plan. The area is located at the intersection of Coulee Trail and CTH F, in the N1/2, SE1/4, Section 6, T28N, R19W in St. Croix County (see Attached Map).

On July 11, 2007, the Hudson Area Sewer Service Committee passed a motion recommending that the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources approve the City of Hudson's request to amend the Hudson Area Sewer Service Plan.

The need for the amendment came about when the School District of Hudson in the Town of Troy applied for annexation to the City of Hudson. The school facility will need to utilize municipal sewer and water services. The Hudson Common Council approved the annexation on April 2, 2007. The amendment request meets the review criteria of the St. Croix County Planning Department for a Type II Amendment.

The approval of this sewer service area amendment does not constitute approval of any other local, state, or federal permit that may be required for sewer construction or associated land development activities.

If you believe you have a right to challenge this decision made by the Department, you should know that Wisconsin statutes, administrative codes and case law establish time periods and requirements for reviewing Department decisions.

To seek judicial review of the Department's decision, sections 227.52 and 227.53, Stats., establish criteria for filing a petition for judicial review. Such a petition shall be filed with the appropriate circuit court and shall be served on the Department. The petition shall name the Department of Natural Resources as the respondent.

To request a contested case hearing pursuant to section 227.42, Stats., and ch. NR 2, Wis. Adm. Code, you have 30 days after the decision is mailed, or otherwise served by the Department, to serve a petition
