Subject: Cedar Creek Classification (Wausau File, WI-0056081-1)

I went out to evaluate Cedar Creek on March 22, 1985. As expected, water levels were high and much ice was still present, so I could not do much. I did determine the water body nearest Wausau File is a wetland. If they wish to discharge to the wetland, the effluent will need to meet standards for a "marginal" receiving water. In my opinion, the preferred discharge would be directly to a flowing part of Cedar Creek. This would require up to 1,500 feet of pipe to convey it to the stream. This should be clearly spelled out to the design engineers.
