SUBJECT: Grant final inspection – City of Appleton Reid Golf Course East & South Ponds

On July 2, 2013 Hanson met with Pete Neuberger of the City of Appleton to observe construction progress and complete final inspection for grant purposes at the City of Appleton Reid Golf Course ponds.

The East pond is nearing completion. Wetland planting on the safety shelf and slope stabilization/seeding are outstanding and should be completed within a week or so. Neuberger will send photos that those are done along with the final reimbursement request and final report. The South pond is complete and full reimbursement of state cost share has been received by City of Appleton. The City of Appleton will ensure that seeding and plantings are maintained given the high visibility and profile of the ponds (located within a public golf course). Photos of both ponds below.
