The Department of Natural Resources (Department) issued a Notice of Intent to Issue a Notice of Discharge on July 8, 2013 for feedlot runoff at your livestock operation located in SE¼ of SE¼ of Section 3, T23N, R13E, Town of Little Wolf, Waupaca County.

The Department completed a site inspection on April 30, 2014 and received documentation from Waupaca County Land and Water Conservation Department confirming that practices necessary to fulfill the Notice of Intent have been completed. At this time, the action of removing the animals and stabilizing the site satisfy the conditions of the July 8, 2013 Notice of Intent.

However, any future discharges of polluted runoff into navigable water will be in violation of Chapter NR 243, Wisconsin Administrative Code and subject to escalated enforcement action. Also note that you are required to follow the conditions of the Animal Restriction Easement recorded on your deed with the Waupaca County Register of Deeds.
