The Town Board of the Town of Washington, Washington Island, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Intent The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resource.

Section 2. Applicability and Enforcement The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Green Bay within the jurisdiction of the Town. The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the officers of the Door County Sheriff's Department, local deputy.

Section 3. State Boating and Water Safety Laws Adopted The statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to water traffic, boats, boating and related water activities and safety in the following enumerated sections of the Wisconsin Statutes are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this ordinance.

"Section 30.66 (2) Fixed Limits In addition to complying with sub. (1), no person may operate a motorboat at a speed in excess of the posted notice as established by regulatory markers."

Section 4. Definitions

"Slow-no-wake" means the slowest possible speed so as to maintain steerage.

Section 5. Area Designated The area designated as a slow-no-wake area shall be as follows:

Township 34, Range 29, Section 25, Town of Washington, Door County, Wisconsin. See attached drawing for detailed placement of buoys.

Section 6. Penalty Section Any person violating this ordinance shall be fined not more than \$200 or imprisoned not more than six months or both, and shall be required to obtain a certificate of satisfactory completion of a safety course under 30.74(1).

Adopted by the Town Board at its regular meeting on February 9, 1987.

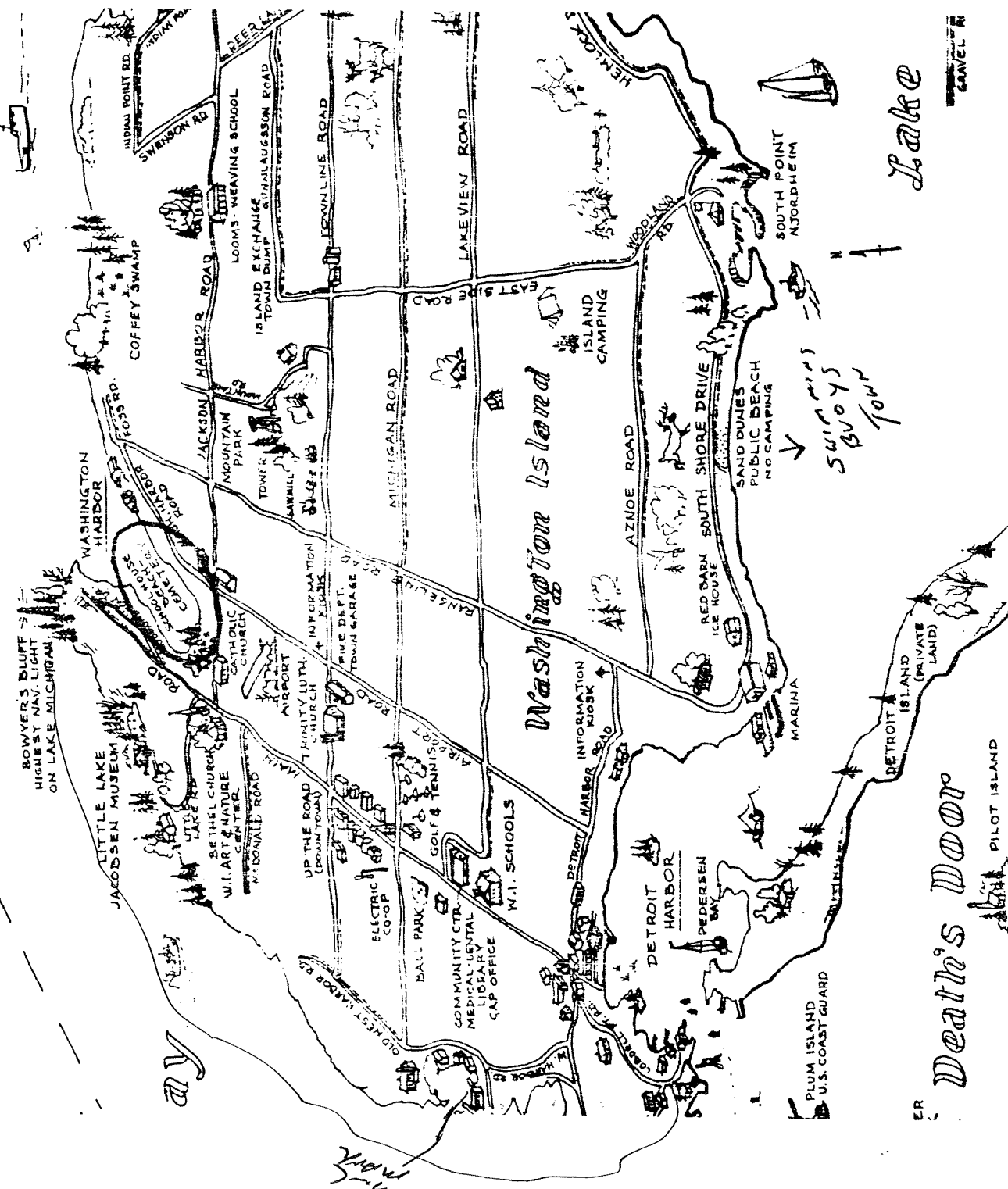

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A SWIMMING AREA PURSUANT TO SECTION 30.77(2) OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES

The Town Board of the Town of Washington, Washington Island, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Purpose The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a swimming area and provide safe and enjoyable aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resource.

Section 2. Applicability and Enforcement The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to Green Bay Waters within the jurisdiction of the Town. The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the officers of the Door County Sheriff's Department, local deputy.

Section 3. State Boating and Water Safety Laws Adopted The statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to water traffic, boats, boating and related water activities and safety found in the following enumerated section of the Wisconsin Statutes are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this ordinance.

Section 30.68(7) Restricted Areas

Section 4. Area Designated The area designated as a swimming area shall be as follows:

Township 34, Range 29, Section 25, Town of Washington, Door County, Wisconsin. See attached drawing for detailed placement of markers.

Section 5. Penalty Section - Any person violating this ordinance shall be fined not more than \$200 or imprisoned not more than six months or both, and shall be required to obtain a certificate of satisfactory completion of a safety course under 30.74(1).
