Narrative space will expand to fit Bon-Home Livestock began constructing improvements to their farm to prevent polluted runoff back in 2012. Bon-Home sits in the karst area of Calumet County so addressing the pollutant issues on this farm was critical. Construction													
began with the development of a feed leachate control system for the farm's stored corn silage. This specific grant was													
aimed at eliminating runoff from their barnyard to a small ditch which contained exposed bedrock, a potential conduit to groundwater. By installing the roof as well as improving the walls to prevent runoff from the barnyard from reaching the													
the ditch this pollutant load was eliminated. There were other stormwater drains throughout the farm that were also													
draining to this ditch carrying polluted runoff that were abandoned, drainage was improved around the farmstead with the													

installation of waterways and significant runoff was reduced by containing liquids from manure stacking areas.




