

The Friends of the Lincoln Community Forest recently held a "Name the Lake Contest" for the unnamed lake on the Lincoln Community Forest. This 400-acre community forest, located in Township 45N, Range 5W, and sections 21 and 22, is owned by the Bayfield Regional Conservancy, and managed in partnership with the Friends group. The small lake is part of this community forest property, and residents and other visitors to the forest have been interested in naming it for many years.

The contest was a success, drawing interest for 36 names being submitted in 118 votes casted. A First Place winner was elected as Makinak Lake. Dear Mr. Winston,

Thank you for letting us know about the 10 acre criteria for naming a lake. The Friends of Lincoln Community Forest are requesting the Geographic Names Council consider this additional evidence to name the lake within the Lincoln Community Forest in Bayfield County, Wisconsin.

We agree that the deep, open water portion of the lake is about 2.5 acres. We ask that you consider the entire water body, which is approximately 13 acres when the shallower, wetland portion of the lake is included.

There are several other special considerations that compelled the Friends of Lincoln Community Forest (Friends group) to request this lake be named:

- The Lincoln Community Forest (Forest) has strong local and regional support. Because of that support, there is already increased public use of the forest and a strong Friends groups that is managing this public use. **A named water body improves that sense of place and gives a stronger connection to the Forest for users.**
- This water body is a **unique feature, relatively pristine and untrammeled.**
- There is **historical connection** through the original homesteader's daughter, who wrote about her experience growing up on the land that included this lake. She referred to it as the "small deep lake". The homesteader, Martin J. Arrhenius, was granted this land under the Homestead Act in 1895 and lived on it from 1888 to 1919.
- The Friends group is developing a management plan that will include education. We plan to **teach the value of wetlands**, using this water body as our focal point.
- We also plan to begin **wildlife monitoring** of the water body as part of our education and public use.
- The Lincoln Community Forest is already used for special events, including the Chequamegon Bay Birding and Nature Festival, which utilize the water body as part of the experience.

To Friends of the Lincoln Community Forest,

This letter is in regard to the unnamed lake that is part of the Lincoln Community Forest (LCF) that is owned and managed by the Bayfield Regional Conservancy with assistance from Friends of Lincoln Community Forest (FLCF) in T45N R5W Section 22 SW1/4.

We support the naming of the lake by FLCF of "Makinak Lake" meaning turtle in the Ojibwe language and the correct spelling and pronunciation verified by Bad River Dental Program Director, Kim Sturm. She said a painting that was painted by a tribal member hangs on the wall in honor of the turtle with the name of makinak in the painting. She also said this painting and spelling was approved by Joe Rose of Bad River.

We understand there may be some different versions for the word "turtle" in the Ojibwe language. Research will find using "The Ojibwe People's Dictionary" that the word for "turtle" is "mikinaak." <http://ojibwe.lib.umn.edu/english/search/turtle?x=0> and the An Ojibwe Word Resource Book edited by John Nichols and Earl Nyholm will list "turtle" as "Mikinaak." Because "Makinak" is how it is spelled in Bad River and confirmed by Bad River, we support the spelling.



Makinak means turtle in the Ojibwe language of Bad River tribe. This is an appropriate name for the lake.





WGNC Proposal: Makinak Lake


