The current name, Squaw Creek, has been deemed as offensive to the Ho-Chunk Nation. Since Squaw Creek almost completely resides on Fort McCoy, it is the intention of Fort McCoy, as a Federal military installation, to work with our Ho-Chunk partners in getting this name changed to a selection that is acceptable to the Nation. Fort McCoy has already changed the name of the Campground several years ago and supports changing the name back to the original Ho-Chunk language to honor the Ho-Chunk people. The use of the traditional Ho-Chunk name is especially appropriate given current efforts by the Ho-Chunk Nation to revitalize their language.

Origin and Significance of Recommended Name ~ Attach Supporting Documents (resolution, historical data, etc.)

According to the Ho-Chunk Nation Language Manager, "Suukjak Sep" means "Black Wolf" in Ho-Chunk. The traditional name for the creek is "Suukjak Sep Ni Samak" meaning "Black Wolf Creek" according to the Ho-Chunk language manager. The name has been Squaw Creek due presumably to document historic use of the creek by the Ho-Chunk in Purdy Valley. The name is seen as offensive by the Ho-Chunk people, and they have asked Fort McCoy to discontinue use of the name and getting the name changed.

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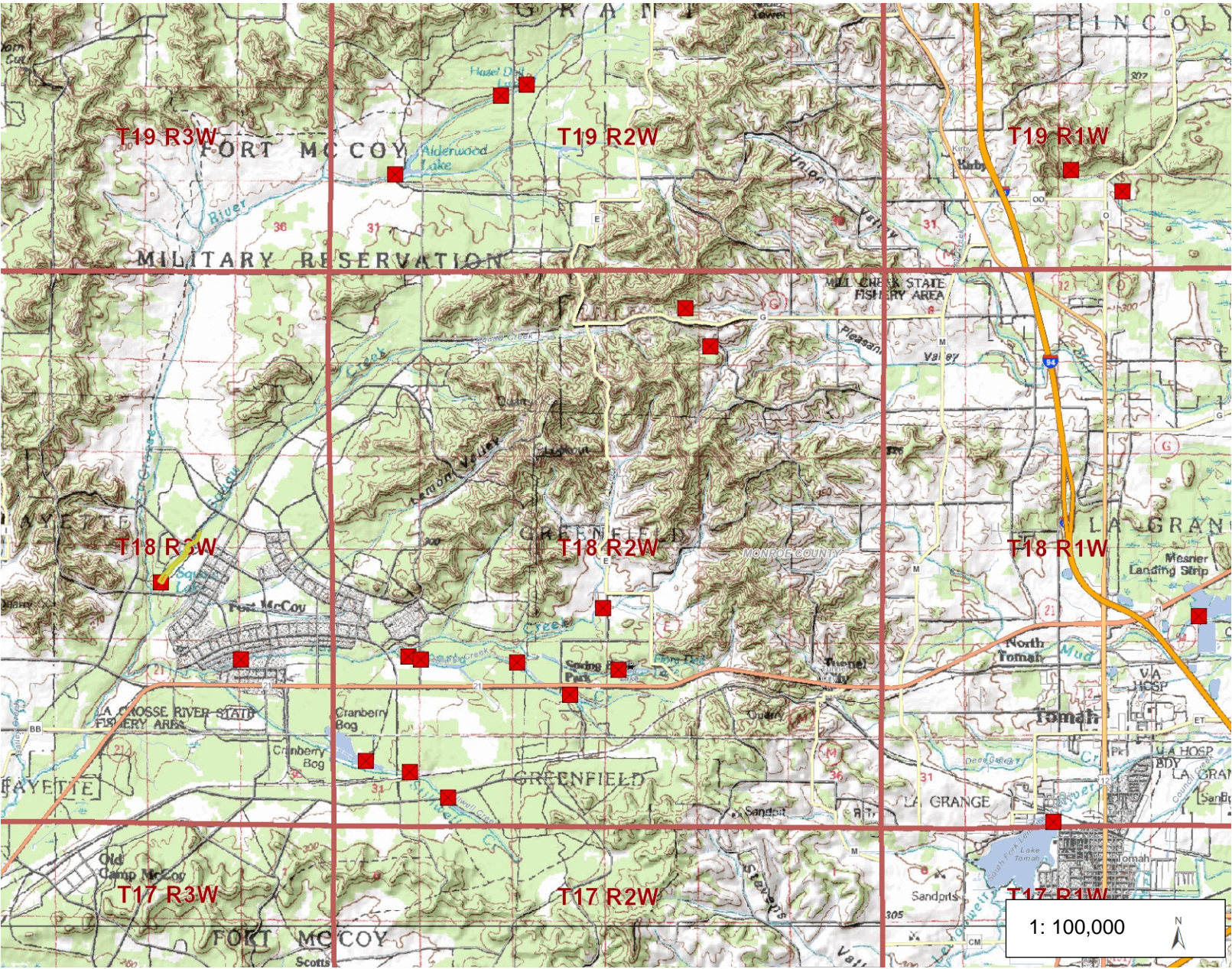

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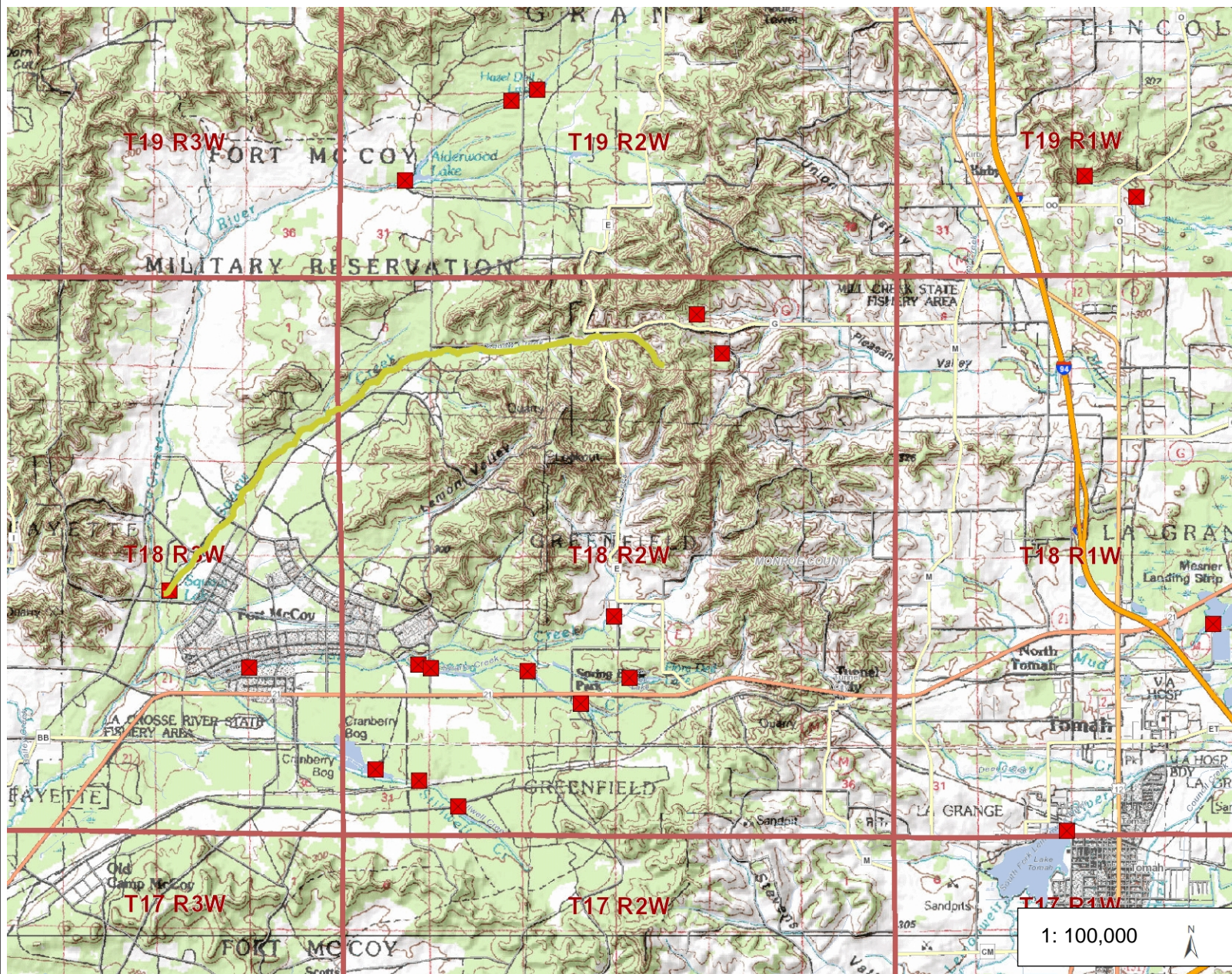
