NOTICE OF CHANGE IN LICENSEE'S NAME

Dear Secretary Bose:

Please be advised that on December 27, 2007, the name of the licensee for the Little Quinnesec Falls Hydro Project (P-2536)¹ and the Kimberly Hydro Project (P-10674)² changed from Stora Enso North America Corp. ("SENA"), a Wisconsin corporation, to NewPage Wisconsin System Inc., a Wisconsin corporation. The Commission has held that a simple name change of a licensee "requires only notice to the Commission," as opposed to instances where the licensee becomes a new legal entity which requires Commission approval.³

The name change did not result in the formation of a new, separate legal entity, and the existing legal entity continues to exist after the name change, albeit with a different name.

Orion Power New York GP II, Inc., et al., 113 FERC ¶ 62,158 (2005) (providing that "Commission approval of a license transfer is required when a transaction results in the licensee becoming a new legal entity, in contrast to a simple name change, which requires only notice to the Commission"); Androscoggin Reservoir Co., et al, 110 FERC ¶ 62,139 n.2 (2005).



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As such, because SENA's name change to NewPage Wisconsin System Inc. did not result in a new, separate legal entity, there is no change in the legal entity that is the licensee, and on that basis, only notice to the Commission is required.

Accordingly, NewPage Wisconsin System Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission change the name of the licensee on all license instruments and documents for these projects to NewPage Wisconsin System Inc. Also, all references to Stora Enso North America Corp. on the docket sheets and service lists for these projects should be changed to NewPage Wisconsin System Inc. and the name NewPage Wisconsin System Inc. should be used in all future correspondence to the licensee.

The change in the name occurred six days after the consummation of a two-step transaction whereby the licensee for Project Nos. 2536 and 10674 was acquired. NewPage Wisconsin System Inc. inadvertently did not inform the Commission of the name change and apologizes for any inconvenience caused by the delay in notifying the Commission of the change in name.
