As per the order approving Purple Loosestrife and Eurasian Water Milfoil Monitoring Plan for the Petenwell-Castle Rock Project (FERC Project No. 1984-078) issued on January 22, 2003, Wisconsin River Power Company (WRPCO) is submitting the survey results for Purple Loosestrife.

The Petenwell and Castle Rock Flowages were surveyed for Purple Loosestrife from July 12, 2005 through July 13, 2005. The presence of Purple Loosestrife was identified on the Petenwell Flowage mainly on the north end. The results of the 2005 Purple Loosestrife survey on the Petenwell Flowage are similar to the results from the 2004 survey.

Purple loosestrife was not identified on the Castle Rock Flowage. One area of Purple Loosestrife was identified during the 2004 survey. The Purple Loosestrife was cut and sprayed using an approved herbicide during that survey and appears to have been controlled. The results from the 2005 Purple Loosestrife survey for the Peterwell and Castle Rock Flowages are attached as Appendix A.

Documentation of submittal of these results to the Agencies can be found in Appendix B.

The schedule for Eurasian Water Milfoil is every three years, with the next survey being conducted in 2006.


