**Recommending to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources
Amendment of the *Dane County Water Quality Plan* by Adopting the Update of
Appendix C: *Point Source Inventory and Analysis***

WHEREAS, in March 1975, Dane County was designated by the Governor of Wisconsin as an area having substantial and complex water quality control problems, and certified such designation to the federal Environmental Protection Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Area Regional Planning Commission is a duly created regional planning commission under Wis. Stat. § 66.0309; and

WHEREAS, the CARPC has an agreement with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) to provide water quality management planning assistance to the WDNR; and

WHEREAS, the *Dane County Water Quality Plan* is the approved areawide water quality management plan for the Dane County region; and


WHEREAS, the Capital Area Regional Planning Commission has adopted, reaffirmed, and recommended amendment of the *Dane County Water Quality Plan*; and


WHEREAS, the Capital Area Regional Planning Commission has prepared an updated Appendix C to the *Dane County Water Quality Plan*, entitled "*Point Source Inventory and Analysis*," and has made the document available to all local units of government in Dane County; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held during the Regional Planning Commission meeting on March 9, 2017, to take testimony on the Appendix including revisions to the report based on public comments received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 66.0309, and Sec. 208 of Public Law 92-500, the Capital Area Regional Planning Commission recommends the amendment of the *Dane County Water Quality Plan* by adopting the updated Appendix C: *Point Source Inventory and Analysis*.
