

Boot and Wader Cleaning Station

Take 60 seconds before and after visiting the river
to protect our fisheries from invasive species that could be hitchhiking on your gear.

Instructions:

1. Drain all water from your waders, boots and gear.
2. Use the three-sided boot brush below to remove mud and debris from your boots.
3. Use the long handled brush to scrub off any remaining mud and debris from your waders and boots.
4. If you have fished out-of-state or on invasive species infested waters within the past five days, further decontamination of gear may be necessary.
