> Amendment to the Dane County Water Quality Plan, Revising the Oregon Urban Service Area

Dear Rahim:

Enclosed is Resolution RPC No. 601 Amending the Dane County Water Quality Plan by revising the boundaries of the Oregon Urban Service Area and adopting additional environmental corridors. The amendment, which was requested by the Village of Oregon, involves an addition of 69 acres, of which 40.9 acres are developable, and a compensating deletion of 40.9 acres of vacant developable land from the service area. The addition includes 28.1 acres of additional environmental corridor. The added land is within the Village of Oregon and the deleted land is located in the Town of Oregon. The purpose of the revision is to reconfigure the urban service area to remove long-term farmland from the service area and add land which is more timely and suitable for development.

The Regional Planning Commission acted on this amendment following a public hearing held on April 9, 1992. Enclosed are copies of the staff analysis (dated 4/6/92) and minutes of the April 9 RPC meeting and public hearing. No testimony or comments were received in opposition to the proposed amendment. We contacted the Town, who took no position on the proposed amendment.

This amendment is being submitted for Department review and approval. If you need additional information, please contact me.

AMENDING THE DANE COUNTY REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT GUIDE,
THE WATER QUALITY PLAN AND THE FARMLAND PRESERVATION PLAN
