Lake Michigan Day celebrates and showcases opportunities for continued restoration and protection of Lake Michigan, engaging stakeholders and policy makers from throughout the region.

This year's event will examine how we can collectively champion Lake Michigan and further enhance Great Lakes literacy across private and public sectors. Our keynote speaker is Cameron Davis, former Obama Administration liaison to Congress on Great Lakes issues. A Mayors' panel led by former Racine Mayor John Dickert, now executive director of the St. Lawrence Great Lakes Cities Initiative, includes Port Washington Mayor Tom Mlada, Sheboygan Mayor Mike Vandersteen, and Manitowoc Mayor Justin Nickels. The 2017 Champions of Conservation will be awarded following lunch. An optional boat tour will explore the Manitowoc River and near shore areas of Lake Michigan with pre-registration required.
