


Figure 2. Initial specimen selected for detailed examination.




Figure 3. Initial specimen, shell disrupted to display body mass. Embryos display as mini marshmallows within the pallial oviduct.




Figure 5. Initial specimen, view of dissected embryos.




Figure 6. Initial specimen, paucispiral operculum with white calcareous smear.




Figure 9. Second specimen, paucispiral operculum with white calcareous smear.
