#### 1205 Work Element – Committee Administration & Coordination

The Sustainable/Efficient Community Services & Facilities Committee, (SECSFC), met on January 9, 2019. This committee acted on the draft 2019 work program pertaining to the 1200 Work Element: Sustainable and Efficient Community Services and Facilities and was approved prior to the full-Commission approval later in the month. Additionally, the summary of proceedings from the October 26, 2018 and December 12, 2018 Summary of Proceedings SECSFC meeting were approved.

### 1232 Work Item - Continuing Management for Sewer Service Area Planning

- Staff reviewed and issued a conformance approval for three sanitary sewer extension projects for the Grand Chute-Menasha West, (3) and Heart of the Valley, SSA's. Staff also reviewed one private lateral for the Oshkosh SSA.
- Met with the Village of Harrison staff discussing potential sewer service needs.
- Staff provided comments on three preliminary plat designs for the Village of Harrison, City of Neenah, and the Village of Black Creek.
- Staff developed some preliminary mapping related to the Town of Clayton and the City of Appleton's proposed service agreement.
- Staff searched for historic WWTF record for the Town of Dale.
- Staff coordinated with the Village of Fox Crossing to provided assistance in finding available vacant land for a SSA Swap Amendment (Amendment Track 158).
- Reviewed NR-121, East Central's SSA Amendment Policies and current WI state law related to wetlands.
- Staff met with residents living within the Sherwood SSA, but within the Village of Harrison to discuss future sewer needs and options.
- Drafted the 2019 Water Quality Management Agreement for the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. Staff also prepared the 2018 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarter billing reports for submittal to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.

- Staff collected demographic data for the Fox Cities 2040 SSA Plan and formatted tables.
- Staff sorted through the Fox Cites 2030 SSA file folders and created new 2040 SSA Plan folders, time-line, and mail list.
