 Upon completion of the manure storage system, the Bergseng Family Dairy will be able to implement a nutrient management plan that meets the NRCS 590 standard. Additionally the discharge from the former manure loading area has been eliminated. Clean water diversion from a large barn roof has been addressed through livestock

fencing and a critical area stabilization practice installation. Due to excessively wet soil conditions in the fall of 2017, the seeding for the critical area stabilization was not successfully established. The landowner will be responsible for ensuring that the sod cover, within the critical area stabilization, is well-established in the spring of 2018.

DNR may use this site as a success story to meet state and federal reporting needs.

**Additional Project Information and/or Comments**

 The manure storage system installation on this dairy farm will greatly assist the operator in managing the manure, produced on this farm, in an environmentally friendly manner. Located in the headwaters of the Kinnickinnic River (South Fork), winter spreading of liquid dairy manure was a significant resource concern for the trout stream. Bergseng Family Dairy developed a nutrient management plan in 2016, and quickly realized that many of their fields contained areas that have winter spreading restrictions. Pierce County LCD staff worked with the farm to identify solutions to the winter spreading issue. Long-term waste storage system was determined to be the most effective means to reducing the potential manure runoff issues on Bergseng's farmland.

Dear Brian,

You are receiving this letter to serve as notice of the requirement of continuing compliance for receiving cost share funds for **Manure Storage Systems, Livestock Fencing and Critical Area Stabilization** from Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, Targeted Runoff Management Program. The cost share funds you received were provided to reduce manure runoff from cropland fields from winter spreading of liquid manure and discharge from manure loading area and a dry cow feedlot.

By accepting the cost share funds, you are agreeing to the requirements of Administrative Rule NR 151.07, NR 151.09 (3) (b) which states that once compliance with an agricultural performance standard is achieved, compliance shall be maintained by the existing landowner, heirs or subsequent owners or operators of the cropland without the offer of additional cost sharing.
