Notice of Trout  
Stream Classification  
Changes in  
Sheboygan County  
Pursuant to NR  
1.02(7)(c), Wis. Adm.  
Code, the Department  
of Natural Resources  
gives public notice of  
the following trout  
stream classification  
changes in Sheboygan  
County:

1.6 miles of Willow  
Creek, in the Town of  
Sheboygan, Sheboygan  
County as a Class  
II Trout water. The  
classified stream seg-  
ment begins just be-  
low Interstate-43 and  
ends with its conflu-  
ence at the Sheboygan  
River. This classifica-  
tion is based upon sur-  
veys which indicate  
that this portion of  
Willow Creek meets  
Class II trout stream  
criteria.

6 miles of the Onion  
River, known locally  
as Ben Nutt Creek, in  
Sections 5 and 6 of the  
Town of Lyndon, and  
Sections 20, 29, 30 and  
31 of the Town of  
Plymouth, Sheboygan  
County from a Class  
II to a Class I Trout  
water. The classified  
stream segment be-  
gins at the headwa-  
ters and ends at the  
confluence with Mill  
Creek, and includes  
the entire length of  
Ben Nutt Creek. This  
classification is based  
upon surveys which  
indicate that Ben Nutt  
Creek meets Class I  
trout stream criteria.

2.2 miles of Mill  
Creek in Sections 5  
and 6 of the Town of  
Lyndon and Section 1  
of the Town of Mitch-  
ell, Sheboygan County  
from a Class II to a  
Class I Trout water.  
The classified stream  
segment begins at the  
headwaters and ends  
at the confluence with  
the Onion River, and  
includes the entire  
length of Mill Creek.  
This classification is  
based upon surveys  
which indicate that  
Mill Creek meets  
Class I trout stream  
criteria.

5.2 miles of the Onion  
River in Sections 4, 5,  
8, 9, 10 and 11 of the  
Town of Lyndon, She-  
boygan County as a  
Class I Trout water.  
The classified stream  
segment begins at the  
confluence with Mill  
Creek and ends at  
CTH N. This classifi-  
cation is based upon  
surveys which indi-  
cate that this portion

of the Onion River  
meets Class I trout  
stream criteria.

This action does not  
have the potential to  
cause significant ad-  
verse environmental  
impacts; therefore,  
the Department has  
made a preliminary  
determination that an  
environmental analy-  
sis will not be re-  
quired for these clas-  
sification changes.

The Department shall  
waive any hearing re-  
quirement on these  
classifications unless  
a written request for  
hearing is received  
before October 13,  
2008. Written requests
