Personal information collected will be used for administrative purposes and may be provided to requestors to the extent required by Wisconsin's Public Records Law (ss.19.31-19.39, Wis. Stats.).

Instructions: Reporting on this form is a requirement of your Purple Loosestrife Biocontrol Permit to move purple loosestrife plants. If you are only moving beetles, the form is not required, however, the data is valuable to the program for evaluation and research information. Estimate data as best you can (e.g. a football field without end zones is ~1 acre). If you need your site's SWIMS Station ID, contact your local/regional coordinator or the Statewide Purple Loosestrife Biocontrol Coordinator. A GPS point and the nearest road or stream crossing will help define the site location. Report one site per page. SWIMS users, please enter the data in your project. Others may provide their coordinator or the Statewide coordinator with the sheet(s) for entry.
