Sec. 11.04.01 AIRCRAFT LANDING PROHIBITED

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person to ascend or land with any aircraft, whether commercial or private, including glider, balloons, seaplanes and helicopters, upon the body of water in the Town of LaValle or the Town of Woodland, Sauk County, Wisconsin, known as Dutch Hollow Lake. This prohibition shall not apply to emergency landings, Military or National Guard personnel, or to any medical helicopter.
- B. For the purpose of this Chapter, the term "commercial aircraft" shall include any aircraft carrying passengers for hire or operated in connection with any other business and carrying passengers primarily for amusement or recreational purposes.
- C. It shall be unlawful for any aircraft, whether "commercial" or otherwise, to make continuous landings and takeoffs, commonly known as "touch and goes" upon the body of water in the Town of LaValle and the Town of Woodland, Sauk County, Wisconsin, known as Dutch Hollow Lake.

Sec. 11.04.02 PENALTIES

Any person violating the provisions of this Chapter shall be punished by a fine or forfeiture of not less than One Hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), along with court costs.
