Estimate of total produced by WDNR in 1996 is 35,640. Additional 15,000 from national efforts at Cornell; 3,580 from USDA-APHIS, and 500 from Minnesota DNR/Univ. of Minnesota. Total released by WDNR in 1996: 54,720. Additional beetles released at Trempealeau NWR.

Total Hylobius WDNR-released in 1996: 2550. Additional weevils released at Trempealeau NWR.
