The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (Department) has received the final 2043 Luxemburg Sewer Service Area Plan. The Plan was submitted for official review March 15, 2023, and Bay Lake Regional Planning Commission worked with the Department over several months during the review process. Bay Lake electronically submitted the final plan on December 20, 2023. The purpose of the Plan is to update Luxemburg's prior sewer service area plan, which was adopted in 2000. The Department approves the 2023 Plan update.

## Statewide Areawide Water Quality Management Plan

This Plan submittal is a formal update to the state's Areawide Water Quality Management Plan and will be forwarded to the US Environmental Protection Agency to meet the requirements of the Clean Water Act of 1987 (Public Law 92-500 as amended by Public Law 95-217) and outlined in the federal regulations 40 CFR, Part 35. This review is an integrated analysis action under section NR 150.20 (2) (a) 3, Wis. Adm. Code. By means of this review, the Department has complied with chapter NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code, and with section 1.11, Wis. Stats. The approval of this Plan does not constitute approval of any other local, state, or federal permit that may be required for sewer construction or associated land development activities.

## **Appeal Rights**

Wisconsin statutes and administrative rules establish time periods within which requests to review Department decisions must be filed. For judicial review of a decision pursuant to sections 227.52 and 227.53, Wis. Stats., a party has 30 days after the decision is mailed, or otherwise served by the Department, to file a petition with the appropriate circuit court and serve the petition on the Department. Such a petition for judicial review must name the Department of Natural Resources as the respondent.

To request a contested case hearing pursuant to section 227.42, Wis. Stats., a party has 30 days after the decision is mailed, or otherwise served by the Department, to serve a petition for hearing on the Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources. All requests for contested case hearings must be made in accordance with section NR 2.05(5), Wis. Adm. Code, and served on the Secretary in accordance with section NR 2.03, Wis. Adm. Code. The filing of a request for a contested case hearing does not extend the 30-day period for filing a petition for judicial review.
