We will be taking a year off to re-evaluate how to improve the communication process and explore ideas of how to hold applicants responsible for following through. Tying state funding up is not ideal and will help make the County budgeting more accurate. This is a good grant opportunity, especially with county cost share dollars becoming sparse. We are looking forward to exploring ways to improve the program to help Washburn County lakes and it's shoreline owners.
