
Pictoral documentaion of starry stonewort (Nitellopsis obtuse) management efforts on Geneya Lake, Summer 2019-2020.




6/18/19. Chemical treatment of Trinke Lagoon Geneva Lake, WI for starry stonewort.

Looking west from Wildwood Dr. The site was to be graded, lined, and banked to allow for the catchment of water from the dewatering bags, into a small collection area from which the water would be released to the Trinke Creek, located to the right and back of the picture. A six-foot high secured fence would enclose the entire dewatering operation.



The air strip dewatering site, looking south. This area was initially proposed for dewatering. The lagoon is to the north approximately 20 ft. behind the spot from which the picture was taken.




8/5/20. Kayakers prepare to bring dive bags of pulled starry stonewort from the dive site to the beach while instructions are being given by the dive team leader.
