

9.18 - BOATING ON BEAVER DAM LAKE. (Cr. #749)

- (1) APPLICABILITY AND ENFORCEMENT. The provisions of this ordinance [section] shall apply to the waters of Beaver Dam Lake. This chapter shall be enforced by the officers of City of Cumberland Police Department and/or by any law enforcement officer of the State of Wisconsin.
- (2) INTENT. The intent of this ordinance [section] is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests and the capability of the water resources.
- (3) STATE BOATING AND SAFETY LAWS ADOPTED. State boating laws as found in Wis. Stats. §§ 30.50 to 30.71, are adopted by reference here.
- (4) PENALTIES. Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in Wis. Stats. § 30.80, and deposits established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conferences, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment are deleted.
- (5) SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this ordinance [section] shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the City of Cumberland would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance [section] irrespective of whether or not one (1) or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance [section] or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.
- (6) DEFINITIONS. "Slow-no-wake" means that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.
- (7) SLOW NO WAKE AREA. No person shall operate a boat faster than slow-no-wake in the waters of Beaver Dam Lake approximately 300 feet directly north of 2nd Avenue and then placing buoys in a line directly SE to Nedvidek Street.
- (8) POSTING REQUIREMENTS.: The City of Cumberland shall place and maintain a synopsis of this ordinance [section] at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the City pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15, Wis. Adm. Code.
