Subject: NR 151 Compliance

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Kinning,

The purpose of this letter is to acknowledge that you have implemented the necessary corrective actions to comply with portions of the Non-Point Pollution State Performance Standards in NR 151, Wis. Adm. Code. The Department, in partnership with the Jackson County Land Conservation Department, has determined the installed Best Management Practices at your operation to be adequate to meet the Agricultural Performance Standards and Prohibitions on the areas described below. As a result of installing the Best Management Practices, the Department and the County have determined that you are now in compliance with the following State Agricultural Performance Standards and Prohibitions at the specific locations below:

| NR 151.08 (4) Prohibition on direct runoff From a feedlot or stored manure | T23N, R6W Section 18, NE ¼ of the SW ¼ |
| NR 151.08 (5) Prohibition on unlimited livestock access to waters of the state | T23N, R6W Section 18, NE ¼, NE ¼ of the NW ¼ |

In accordance with Ch. NR 151, Wis. Adm. Code, any practice or facility that is in compliance with a performance standard or prohibition on or after the effective date of the standard or prohibition, must remain in compliance regardless of whether cost-sharing is provided to the owner or operator. Since you are now deemed in compliance with the performance standards and prohibitions listed above, it is imperative that you and any future owners or operators maintain compliance with them.

I want to personally thank you for working with the Department and the County to eliminate your cattle from the area near the creek bank and contain the manure being generated from the cattle around the buildings. Your efforts in this matter have contributed to improved water quality of Timber Creek.
