CBCW & Education Project.


As last year the project consisted almost exclusively of the monitoring activity at the Kimball Lake
landing and the Nancy Lake landing at the Deeper Lake site and the mailing of educational materials to
lake residents. A copy of the letter to residents and a brochure we enclosed with the letter is among the
attachments here. I have included data on the number of boats monitored on each lake and the people
encountered for the past two years. All data has been entered into SWIMS. We monitored the landings
slightly more hours than last year. This was primarily due to the earlier fishing opener weekend in May.
The number of boats monitored grew slightly on Kimball Lake and fell slightly on Lake Nancy. It is not
clear why there were fewer boats monitored on Nancy. Certainly, the weather was conducive to
boating for the most part. I noticed reduced boat traffic on the lake so perhaps it was partially due to
the fact that folks did not come to the lake as often as last year because of the poor economic
conditions.

We did not have many instances of aquatic vegetation being attached to boats coming out of the water.
This could be due to the fact that it was a wetter year, and the water level was considerably higher than
last year. The EWM in Lake Nancy did not "top out" in many locations. Nor did we have any incidents at
either landing with boaters who did not want to cooperate with the inspectors.

If I have failed to provide any necessary information for our report, please let me know.
