Access 2011 (Clark): Within Black Wolf Run golf course in Kohler, west of I43, south of Hwy 28, north of Hwy 28. Access controlled by the Kohler Co.									
Core Site Summary  Inventory concentrated on forested areas along the Sheboygan River. There are some small fair and good quality areas of northern mesic forest (waypts. 1-3,5,8,11,12,17-20,22,28) with sugar maple, red oak, beech, and white pine. There are a few seeps (waypt 11,20) in NMF with ostrich fern and skunk cabbage. There are several areas of floodplain and floodplain terrace (waypts 4, 7, 15, 35,34) with young white ash, larger cottonwood, and crack willow and an old oxbow (waypt 25,26) with white ash, box elder, crack willow. Steep eroded riverside slopes have degraded NMF and white sedar stands. The better quality areas of NMF and some of the floodplain areas have fairly rich herb layers.  Site significance: Some of the only remaining forested areas along the Sheboygan River's lower portion. There are small but fair to good quality areas of NMF and some fair quality floodplain forest areas with a rich herb layer.  Management Considerations  Garlic mustard is common, especially bad infestation at waypoint 12. It would take a significant effort to control its spread. Common buckthorn and Dame's rocket are common to abundant and widespread.
