Other Clear Lake News:

Eurasian Water Milfoil (EWM) Update

The modified final plan was submitted to the WDNR for review & comment on 6/8/07. We've noticed several patches of EWM with the warm up the last week. Our intention is to mark these "colonies" with **RED** and/or **BLUE** markers. Please refrain from motoring thru these areas to avoid fragmentation & spreading of the weed until we develop an eradication plan.

WHAT CAN EACH OF US DO AS INDIVIDUALS TO PREVENT AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES (AIS) ON CLEAR LAKE?

 Thorough & regular watercraft inspection of your & your guest's equipment for AIS.
 Remove all weeds & debris from your equipment B4 off loading into area waters.
 Empty live wells before pulling your boat out.

- 2. Refrain from removing native vegetation from your shoreline.
- 3. Refrain from using phosphorus, nitrogen & potassium nutrients (instead, specifically use phosphorus-free fertilizers).
- 4. Restoration of natural shorelines. Refrain from mowing to the waters edge. A buffer is the most effective way to prevent excessive nutrients & sediments from reaching the lake.
- 5. A new fish virus that caused fish kills in several eastern Great Lakes in 2005 and 2006 has been detected in fish in Wisconsin's Lake Winnebago System and Lake Michigan.
 Viral Hemorrhagic Septicemia, or VHS virus, is not a threat to people who handle infected fish or want to eat their catch, but it can kill a broad range of native fish.

To prevent VHS from spreading to inland waters, the Natural Resources Board in April and May passed prohibiting movement of live fish and water from lakes and rivers where the virus has been found or is likely present, and started requiring people who harvest and sell bait from the wild to get a bait dealer's permit.

Fur

The inquisitive little muskrat can still be seen playing hide-n-seek with boaters on the NW end.

Fowl

We've noticed a good number of bald eagles frequenting the lake this year. Look for the nest again in the large white pine behind & t right of John Stahmer's #31. Have seen a single osprey three times in June.

Fishing

Good crappie and pan fish action week of 5/28/07 is reported. Fish the shallows with jigs tipped with crawlers or minnows.
