The Department has scheduled a public informational hearing at the times and places listed above for the purpose of giving all interested persons an opportunity to make a statement with respect to the proposed TMDL and the update of the Areawide Water Quality Management Plan. A hearing officer will conduct the hearing in an orderly and efficient manner and will use procedures necessary to insure broad public participation in the hearing. The office will open the hearing and make a concise statement of the scope and purpose of the hearing and Department staff will give a brief presentation on the proposed TMDL. The hearing officer may put limits on individual oral statements to insure an opportunity for all persons present to make statements in a reasonable amount of time and to prevent undue repetition. Information and clarifying questions

and oral statements shall be directed through the hearing officer. Cross-examination shall not be allowed.

Department staff will be present at the hearing location for 30 minutes in advance of the hearing and for a short time immediately afterward for questions and further information.
