SSA Plan Updates & Mapping

East Central staff continued to work on the Fond du Lac, Brillion and Sherwood 2030 SSA Plan Updates as follows:

- Priority development areas were determined for the 2030 Brillion SSA plan update. The
 identified areas were cross-referenced to the calculated acreage allocations for the service area.
 Acreage additions were then placed within the priority areas for comparisons. In addition, an
 informational meeting was scheduled with the Town of Rantoul in mid-January.
- The Fond du Lac SSA existing land use data was further refined with respect to environmental features. Future land use was updated for the Town of Calumet based on a comprehensive plan submitted by the Town. The Outside Sewer Group continued to meet to determine a 50 year growth scenario for communities contributing wastewater to the Fond du Lac treatment plant.

East Central staff continued to work on other SSA issues as follows:

- Summary of proceedings were completed from the December 12, 2012 Community Facilities
 Committee meeting.
- Staff facilitated the January 25, 2013 Community Facilities Committee meeting approving Resolution 6-13 approving the 2020 Poygan SSA update. Efforts began to finalize the mapping and document text for WDNR certification.

Staff continued to work with the Town of Algoma and its design to consolidate with the Omro SD. #1. Discussions included the potential for an amendment to the 2030 Oshkosh SSA giving rise to the development of planning area amendment policies. Contractual issues for service provision continued with the City of Omro. This issue has since been discussed with the WDNR via a conference call in which the Designated Management Agency status and the requirement of facilities planning were topics of discussion.

East Central staff continued to work on sewer service area activities as follows:

- Document text for the 2030 Sherwood SSA plan update was submitted to the Village of Sherwood to solicit comments.
- A draft acreage allocation mapping and data tables were prepared and submitted the information to the City of Brillion, Town of Brillion and Town of Rantoul for their review and comment. Future meetings with the various plan commissions will be scheduled to resolve any conflicts. Staff continued to edit and update the Brillion SSA plan text.
- o Staff began preparing the final draft text and draft mapping for the recently approved 2020 Poygan SSA plan update. The draft plan was then submitted to the WDNR for certification.
- The Fond du Lac Outside Sewer Group executive committee continued to meet to update their 50 year growth plan.

<u>Sewer Extension / Facilities Plan Reviews</u> No reviews or approvals were conducted.

- o Discussions were held with the City of Oshkosh regarding a potential amendment request to the 2030 Oshkosh SSA.
- o Follow-up conversations and meetings with the Algoma S.D. regarding a continued push to amend the 2030 Oshkosh SSA. In addition, information was relayed to the district based on a previous conference call with the WDNR in January, 2013.
- Staff completed the summary of proceedings from the January 25, 2013 Community Facilities Committee meeting. Efforts began to create the agenda and meeting memo for the March 13, 2013 CFC scheduled meeting.
- o Prepared the 2012 3rd and 4th quarter Water Quality Management billing reports. The 2013 Water Quality Management Application was prepared and submitted to the WDNR.
- o Additional information and data was submitted to the Wisconsin Geological and Natural History Survey regarding the Soil/Water Balance Model. This project when completed by the WGNHS has the potential for incorporation in sewer service area planning.
