After reviewing the total nutrient budgeting to Cedar L., the 1<sup>o</sup> source of nutrient input appears to be runoff from poor land use activities in the watershed. The cost inhibiting aspects of controlling runoff seem too great at the present time. Suggestion of best land management practices by SCS, etc. seems to be the way to go. If macrophytes become a problem physical harvesting appears to be the ~~way~~<sup>temp. solution</sup> to go. In addition to the benefits you list I would like to add the immediate attract harvesting others. Thank you for keeping us informed regarding your activities in the District.
